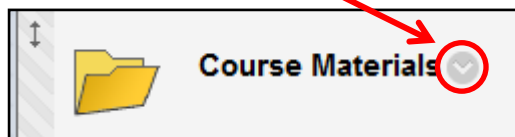


Removing Links on Content Pages in HuskyCT

Step 1: Access the option menu for the item to be hidden or unhidden

Mouse over the content link until the **gray menu arrow** appears

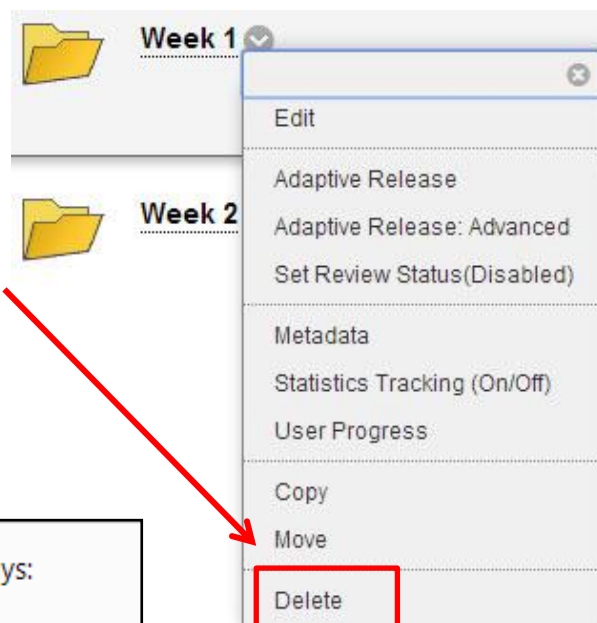
NOTE: Edit Mode must be ON



Step 2: Choose the option to "Delete"

Click on **"Delete"**
This is usually at the bottom of the menu

You will be asked to confirm this action

Consequences:

Deleting a link to a File removes the link from the content page and students no longer have access to the file. The file itself, however, will still be in the Content Collection and **can be re-added if needed**.

Deleting a link to a Test removes the link from the content page and removes student access. The Test itself, however, will still be in the Tests, Surveys, and Pools tool and **can be re-added if needed**.

Deleting a link to an Assignment removes the link from the content page and permanently removes the assignment. It is not stored anywhere and it is **not recoverable**.

Deleting a link to a Content Folder permanently removes the Folder, making all materials in the Folder no longer accessible. Files and Tests that were in the Folder can be recovered. Folders or Assignments that were in that folder are **not recoverable**.
